PRODUCT NAME: **CHEMSORB**

ISSUE No. of Product Specification - Formulation & Manufacture to which this document refers: 001

GENERAL DESCRIPTION: An off-white powder with a pleasant floral odour.

USE FOR WHICH PRODUCT IS INTENDED: For the easy removal of body fluids from a variety of different substrates and in conjunction with CHEMTABS for the removal of body fluids suspected to be contaminated with the **AIDS** virus.

SPECIAL EQUIPMENT REQUIRED: The Chemaide HYGIENE PACK containing disposable gloves and apron together with a plastic disposable scoop and plastic bag with tie for safe disposal.

METHOD AND CONDITIONS OF USE:

- 1. Where the AIDS virus is not suspected and on carpets and fabrics.**
  - a) Put on gloves and apron.
  - b) Sprinkle CHEMSORB liberally onto the surface to be treated ensuring complete coverage.
  - c) Leave for approximately two minutes.
  - d) Use scraper and scoop to remove spillage into the plastic bag and fasten securely with the tie,
  - e) Dispose of by incineration.
  
- 2. Where the AIDS virus is suspected but not on delicate carpets or fabrics.**
  - a) Dissolve 1 CHEMTAB in 100ml of warm water.
  - b) Put on gloves and apron
  - c) Spray solution of CHEMTAB liberally onto spillage to be treated.
  - d) Sprinkle CHEMSORB liberally over entire surface to be treated.
  - e) Allow to act for approximately 2 minutes.
  - f) Carefully scoop up spillage using disposable scraper, scoop into the plastic bag, and fasten securely with the tie.
  - g) Dispose of by incineration.

In either of the methods it may be necessary to carry out more than one treatment.

Old spillages can be treated by re-wetting with plenty of water and carrying out either procedure 1 or 2 above.
